

About Winter/Summer School

Dear young colleagues,

The ESCVES is the oldest world's organization that gathers cardiac and vascular surgeons. Namely the Society was founded in Turin in Italy in 1951, while in 1952 in Strasbourg in France the Society had its first congress. After that, annual congresses followed each year.

One of the main goals of the ESCVES concerns young doctors. This is why professor Domenico Palombo, one of our previous presidents, initiated school for young vascular and cardiac surgeons. The first winter school was organized in Aosta Valley in Italy in 2012. It was followed with schools organized in: Izmir-Turkey 2013, Belgrade-Serbia 2014, Heraklion-Greece 2015, Porec-Croatia 2016, Zabze-Poland 2017, Prague -Czech Republik 2017, Genoa-Italy 2018 and Patras-Greece 2018.

This winter school includes practical and theoretical sections. The Practical will be related to anastomotic techniques with practicing on 3D printed model and porcine aortic arch and infrarenal aorta. Theoretical section will be organized in a "meet the expert" fashion in order to provide participants to discuss different controversial topics. Participant will be invited to come with already prepared questions for experts and they will discuss it in a small group (1 expert: 2-3 participants). Question can be related to particular case or particular technique or any other issue related to our professional life.

Hopefully this winter school will be very useful, for your everyday practice and professional carrier.
